

3 Target Groups

TG1: students/staff of partner universities

TG2: students/staff/degree holders from the countries of partner universities

TG3: members of vulnerable groups of these countries

Important notice:

- Students must have successfully completed at least one year of undergraduate study
- All grantees must have adequate knowledge of the language of their target country
- must NOT have resided in an EU country for more than a total of 12 months during the last five years (this rule does not apply to TG3 candidates)
